OUR VISION



- The lessons are taught through video tutorials, eliminating the need for a computer teacher to be physically present in the classroom.
- Tests are conducted after the completion of each module and certificates are awarded to successful students.




Student Count




Hours Trained


In December, we hosted a 2D Animation Bootcamp, where 30 students acquired new skills in the field of animation, nurturing both their technical and artistic abilities.


